Who can attend the meeting?

The Annual Parish Meeting is a meeting of all the local government electors for the Parish. It is **NOT** a meeting of the Parish Council although the Chairman will chair the meeting if present. Anyone may attend but only registered electors of Ilton Parish may speak and vote.
